Before beginning any service work turn off the PTO, set the parking brake, turn off the ignition.

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- 1. Park the tractor on a smooth, level surface such as a concrete floor. Disengage the PTO, engage the parking brake, turn off the engine, and remove the ignition key.
- 2. Open the hood to gain access to the existing fuel tank vent lines. Remove the existing fuel tank vent lines from the mower and discard.




Figure 1. Vent Hose Routing

- Spray or dip soapy water (use a 1:10 solution of dish soap to water) on the leading edge of the grommet (B, Figure 1) Carefully install the grommet into the tank.
- Spray or dip soapy water (use a 1:10 solution of dish soap to water) on the leading edge of the elbow fitting (C).
- 5. Slowly insert the elbow fitting into the tank. Take care to avoid damaging the grommet while installing the elbow fitting.
- Slide the hose clamp (D) onto the fuel tank vent hose (F). Install the fuel tank vent hose onto the elbow and secure with the hose clamp.
- Insert 3/4" (1,9cm) of the long end of the fuel tank vent tube (G) into the fuel tank vent hose and secure with the #4 hose clamp (F).
- 8. Replace the existing vinyl clamp on the radiator shroud that the fuel tank vent line was routed through with the new tube clamp.
- 9. Hang the fuel tank vent tube in the new tube clamp.
- 10. Repeat process for other side of the machine.
