TOPIC: HYDRO BELT TENSION SPRING

AFFECTED: HW32, HW36 & HW48

Serial no. 197-227, 2166-2385 & 1783-2153 (respectively)

Field reports have indicated the belt tension spring (20807) for the transmission drive belt is breaking due to the anchoring method. To rectify this problem, a HW Spring Anchor Assembly (44800) is available through the Parts Department.

## **Installation Instructions**

- 1. Park machine on a flat, level surface and apply parking brake.
- 2. Remove rear engine deck screen and set aside.
- 3. Remove and discard the extension spring (20807) that tensions the hydro belt idler arm. (This is the spring that is hooked through the side of the engine deck.)
- 4. Assemble bracket, 5/16-18 x 1-1/4" bolt and 5/16-18 serrated flange nut as shown below.
- 5. Install new spring mount bracket in holes used to anchor the spring. Assemble with the supplied 3/8-16 x 3/4" bolts and 3/8-16 serrated flange nuts, inserting the bolt from inside the engine deck. Be sure the 5/16" bolt in the spring mount bracket is pointing downward.
- 6. Attach the new spring to the idler arm and new spring mount bracket. Install the 5/16-18 nylon lock nut on the spring mount bracket to secure spring.
- 7. Reinstall the rear engine deck screen.
